



2023 COMMUNITY IMPACT REPORT



CONNECTIONS MADE








ASSISTANCE PROVIDED



- Navigated patients to over \$11,000 in financial aid through outside agencies. (Angel Flight, Cancer Cares, Hearts & Homes, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, River Valley Ovarian Cancer Alliance, etc.)
- Facilitated cancer support groups led by licensed counselors for adults and children.
- Assisted out-of-town patients with temporary housing options in partnership with The First Presbyterian Church and Hope House at Cavanaugh Methodist Church.
- Partnered with Johnson Dermatology to provide free skin cancer screenings, Arkansas Prostate Cancer Foundation for free prostate cancer screenings and UAFS School of Dental Hygiene for free oral cancer screenings.
- Reached thousands of area youth with vital information about sun safety with our Sun SMART Program and "Take a Stand, Don't Tan" in partnership with the Arkansas Cancer Coalition and the River Valley Skin Cancer Alliance.
- Presented 731 congratulatory Daisy Bundles to those finishing Radiation Treatments.
