How do we help our Cancer Fighters and protect them against the Coronavirus? We feel like we met the Challenge and were able to assist hundreds of Cancer patients and their families in their fight by providing the vital programs and services we have for 42 years but, in a safe and controlled way.

During 2020, the Reynolds Cancer Support House was proud to safely navigate cancer fighters, survivors and their caregivers to vital programs and services that included:

ASSISTANCE PROVIDED

- Registered hundreds of newly diagnosed patients.
- Organized one-on-one patient navigation through private video conferencing.
- Partnered with the River Valley Food Bank to provide liquid nutrition (Boost & Ensure) and other food items to hundreds of cancer patients.
- Provided gas vouchers and city transit bus passes for travel to and from treatment; wigs and head coverings; financial assistance for utilities, prescription and dental services; medical supplies including mastectomy and ostomy supplies.



CONNECTIONS MADE

- Distributed with Mary Kay and the "1000" Miracles Beauty Kits Campaign in partnership with a local Mary Kay Representative.
- Navigated patients to over \$24,000 in financial aid through outside agencies. (Angel Flight, Cancer Cares, Hearts & Homes, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, River Valley Ovarian Cancer Society, TAG Grants, etc)
- Facilitated education sessions & seminars led by medical professionals via YouTube.
- Facilitated Virtual weekly support groups led by licensed therapist.
- Partnered with the Arkansas Arts Council for a therapeutic art program for adolescent cancer survivors.
- Provided free screenings for Skin and Prostate cancer in partnership with Johnson Dermatology and the Arkansas Prostate Cancer Foundation.
- Reached over 5,000 youth with vital information about sun safety with our Sun SMART Program

In 1978, the Cancer Support Foundation was organized to fulfill the mission of providing non-medical services, counseling, transportation and support for persons and families who have been diagnosed as having cancer and to provide these services to all persons regardless of income, age, sex, race or national origin.
