During 2021, the Reynolds Cancer Support House was proud to safely navigate cancer fighters, survivors and their caregivers to vital programs and services. We assisted hundreds of cancer patients and their families during their cancer treatment and beyond.

## ASSISTANCE PROVIDED

- Registered hundreds of newly diagnosed patients.
- Provided one-on-one patient navigation through private video conferencing.
- Partnered with the River Valley Food Bank to provide liquid nutrition.
- (Boost & Ensure) and the Community Services Clearing House to provide food to cancer patients.
- Provided gas vouchers and city transit bus passes for travel to and from treatment; wigs and head coverings; financial assistance for utilities, prescription and dental services; medical supplies including mastectomy and ostomy supplies.



## CONNECTIONS MADE

- Navigated patients to over \$11,500 in financial aid through outside agencies. (Angel Flight, Cancer Cares, Hearts & Homes, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, River Valley Ovarian Cancer Society, TAG Grants, etc)
- Facilitated virtual education sessions & seminars led by medical professionals.
- Facilitated weekly support groups led by licensed therapist.
- Partnered with the Arkansas Arts Council for a therapeutic art program for adolescent cancer survivors.
- Facilitated monthly support group meetings for our Kids Kicking Cancer group.
- Partnered with Johnson Dermatology to provide free skin cancer screenings and the Arkansas Prostate Cancer Foundation to provide free prostate cancer screenings.
- Reached over 5,000 youth with vital information about sun safety with our Sun SMART Program and Take a Stand, Don't Tan in partnership with the Arkansas Cancer Coalition and River Valley Skin Cancer Alliance.
- Distributed with Mary Kay and the "1000" Miracles Beauty Kits Campaign in partnership with a local Mary Kay Representative.
- Sponsored congratulatory Daisy Bundles to those finishing Radiation Treatments.
